




The Locker educates and empowers youth, through Service Learning, to meet the needs of others in their community so that every child has a sense of normalcy

think kids wanting to help each other is a great idea. It encourages them to want to continue to help.


Just like the leaves on the trees, we are changing the landscape of our communities.
